University of North Texas Academic Scholarship Agreement

1. Meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of the Master of Science in Criminal Justice Program;
2. Be a first semester graduate student in the Department of Criminal Justice;
3. Enroll as a part-time or full-time student in the Master of Science in Criminal Justice Program at the University of North Texas;
4. Be available to attend Department of Criminal Justice and College of Public Affairs and Community Service events as requested for one year upon receiving the scholarship; and
5. Submit an essay which includes the following (please limit your essay to 750 words):
 - a.) Why you desire a career in criminal justice,
 - b.) Description of any prior criminal justice experience,
 - c.) Description of your service activities, and
 - d.) Reasons you believe you should be awarded this scholarship.
